Update Software.

It may seem obvious, but updating software is one of the easiest ways to keep your personal information secure. Most companies provide automatic

updates and will send reminders so you can easily install the updates. If you are not receiving automatic software updates, set a reminder to do so quarterly. Be aware that some cyber criminals will send fake updates; these typically appear as a pop-up window when visiting a website. Use good judgement and always think before you click.

RECOGNIZE AND REPORT PHISHING ATTACKS

Do not take the bait when cyber criminals go phishing. The signs of a phishing attack can be subtle, so take the extra time to thoroughly inspect emails. Most phishing emails include offers that are too good to be true, an urgent or alarming tone, misspellings and poorly crafted language, ambiguous greetings, strange requests, or an email address

that does not match the company it coming from. Most platforms like Outlook, Gmail and Mac Mail allow users to report phishing emails. If you suspect a phishing attempt, take an extra minute to report it.
