STAY CYBER SECURE



- Consider using a password manager.
- Create strong passwords that are 12-16 characters and include upper and lower case letters, numbers, and special characters.
- Don't use the same password for multiple accounts.
- Don't open emails from unknown senders.
- Never email your social security number or any financial information.
- Limit what you share on social networking sites.
- Consider using a pop-up blocker.
- Use two factor authentication when available.
- Don't stay signed into accounts. Always log off each site.
- Download attachments only when they are from trustworthy sources.

Guard Your Cards

Basic credit/debit card safety can reduce your exposure to fraud.

- Store cards safely when not in use.
- Always memorize your pins, never write them on the card or share them with others.
- Make a list of account numbers, expiration dates, and customer service numbers that you can access quickly if you lose your card.
- Go paperless with bills and statements.
- Check your statements and accounts regularly. Look for unfamiliar charges.
- Don't allow websites to remember your card number.
