

# Pest Control Museum

In 2017, Bee Extraction Expert Eric "Critter" McCool opened a dedicated pest control museum in Franklin, Pennsylvania. The museum displays a large collection of pest control products and tools representing 150 years of the industry's heritage. Although McCool specializes in bees, the museum includes a broad array of pest control including sprayers, mouse traps, fly swatters, packaged products and more.

McCool spent 30 years amassing the vast collection of tools and products for the display. The museum represents a great opportunity for both professionals in the industry and the public to learn more about the pest control industry.

The museum is the first of a three-phase project for the location. The next phase will be the Stinging Insect Research and Training Center which will be an international training facility geared toward product testing, venom collection, and pesticide research and development. Phase three of the project will be McCool's corporate facility and a storefront.

McCool travels the country providing training sessions. He has also done some international training.
