

Giddy Up & Grow Capital Campaign: Final Phase



Our Impact

The Children's TherAplay Foundation, Inc. is a pediatric outpatient clinic where licensed therapists provide children with disabilities and/or unique needs physical, occupational, and speech therapy which uses the movement of a horse as a tool to accelerate physical, emotional, and behavioral development.

The Need

Families who have a child with a disability desire opportunities to engage, connect, and learn from and alongside members of their community.

Our Children's TherAplay family is growing and we need open, uninterrupted space to facilitate big movement activities. Physical therapists will utilize this space for vector supported gait training, gross motor activities, and open field play.

The Solution

Our new Community Engagement Center will help make meaningful engagement possible by offering families opportunities to connect with resources and education available in the community. Our new space will meet family's needs in the following ways:

- Workshops and educational events with other disability service organizations to help inform families and the community.
- Space to host 75 to 100 people for conferences, workshops, and family-focused social events.
- On-site childcare room for community events.
- Additional gym space with high ceilings for therapy equipment, large open space for bike riding and obstacle courses, and an ADA-accessible ramp to the arena area.
