NOTES

1. Fees are likely to change due to economic reasons.
2. Married students with families in the Moffat campus are charged monthly house rent depending on the size of the house occupied, water and electricity. These bills must be paid on monthly basis.
3. All boarding students are expected to be off campus during mid-term break and vacation. The college does not provide boarding services over such periods.
4. The policy of the College requires full payment of fees at the beginning of the term. However, as a courtesy to the sponsors who may be struggling with fees, the college accepts a minimum of 50% of the fees at the beginning of the term and the balance paid in full on arrival from mid-term break. Students who report without the proper amount of fees should not be allowed to register for classes or stay in campus.
5. **DO NOT** pay fees in cash. Payments should be paid by cheques payable to Moffat Bible College or direct deposit into Moffat Bible College Equity account No. 111 0299 420 526, Kimende Branch. For foreign checks please first consult Moffat finance office for instructions.
6. Online students will pay 2,000/= per credit hour. The payment is payable upon allocation of courses.

8. For the purpose of part time learning, tuition per Credit Hour is Ksh. 2,000 for Diploma courses and Ksh. 1,500 for Certificate courses. The payment is payable upon allocation of courses.
